Becoming a

Master Teacher

It takes perseverance to become a Master Teacher. Here's a look at the process.

Level 100

Candidates go through three months of foundational coursework in five subject areas.





Candidates complete in-ratio and out-of-ratio assignments and pass five Level 100 tests to move on to Level 200. *Minimum passing score: 80%

Level 200

Candidates earn a pay increase and move on to Level 200 coursework. assignments, and tests



Candidates participate in a two week practicum applying what they've learned so far in each classroom in their learning track.



Level 300 3 Months

Candidates earn another pay increase and move on to Level 300 self-reflection, action planning, evidence collection, and the Final Exam.



Upon passing the Final Exam with a score of 80% or higher, candidates earn a third pay increase and become a Certified Master Teacher. Certified Master Teachers take on additional coaching and mentoring responsibilities in the school.
